Cúllar Vega sits at the heart of the Vega of Granada. It borders the municipalities of Las Gabias, Vegas del Genil and Churriana de la Vega (with the Dílar River, which rises on the slopes of Sierra Nevada, dividing both villages). Cúllar Vega offers an ideal location, only 9 km from the city of the Alhambra, 13 minutes drive from Granada's airport and 45 minutes drive from Sierra Nevada, the Alpujarras or the beaches of Granada. Its location among natural areas of great value, its local cuisine and its people make Cúllar Vega a fantastic place to spend the weekend.
